Nor does this competition require you to spend the better part of a day out in the cold, drinking cup after cup of hot chocolate to stay warm as you mold and dress your snowman to perfection... to only enjoy the final masterpiece a short while later before it slowly melts before your eyes!

❄️ Lot Sizes:

- ★ Single snowman lots consist of a 1'x1' plywood base containing only 1 snowman.
- ★ Family snowman lots consist of a 2'x 2' plywood base containing more than 1 snowman.

❄️ Judging Categories:

- ★ Edible (at least 51% edible)– *Single or Family lot size*
- ★ Non Edible –*Single or Family lot size*
- ★ School Class Room Entry (may be edible or non-edible)-*Family size lot only*

The Snowman Lane entries will be on display in the Lodge Discovery Center the entire month of December.

Judging of the Snowman Lane Competition will take place on December 17, 2008. Competition participants do not need to be present to win.

The Snowman Lane entries will be auctioned off to the highest bidders during a silent auction to be held December 1, 2008-December 23, 2008. All proceeds of the auction will benefit local Kittitas County food banks.

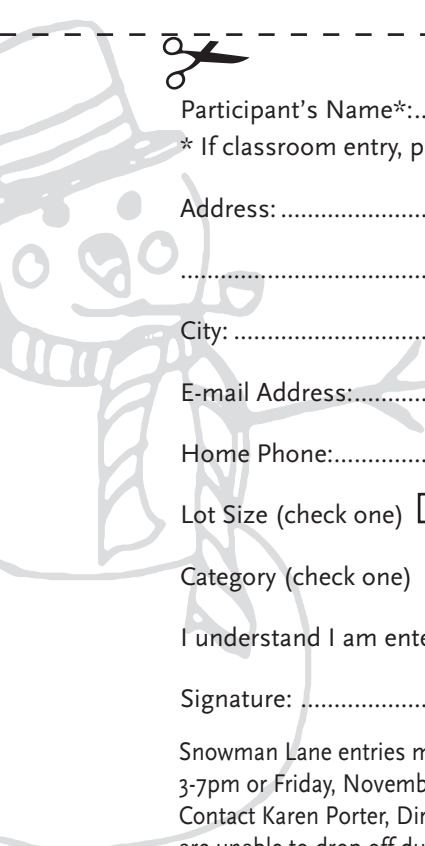
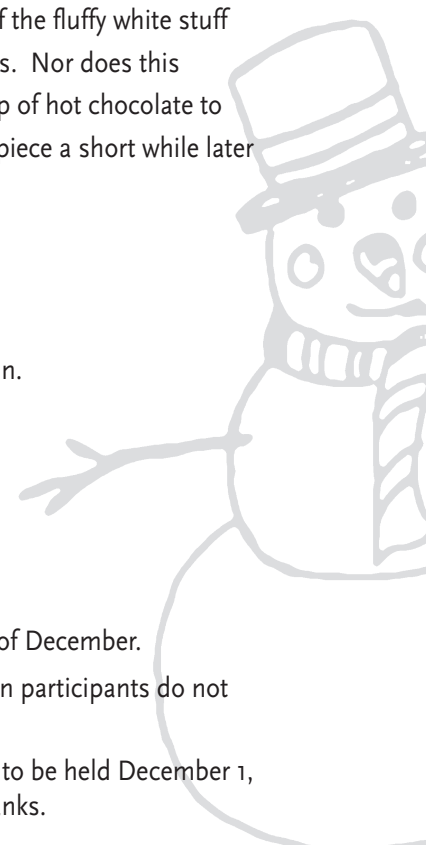

2. Entries will be displayed at the Discovery Center in The Lodge at Suncadia. Suncadia reserves the right to display entries in other locations based on space limitations.
3. The snowmen in each entry must meet the snowman dimensions as outlined in the kits below. Purchasing a kit is not required but recommended to meet criteria for design.
4. Attach a 3" x 5" card listing your name and address (as listed on entry form) on the underside of your display base.
5. All entries must remain at Suncadia for display from November 29, 2008 through January 2, 2009.
6. Suncadia is not responsible for any damage that may occur while entry is on display. Furthermore, it reserves the right to remove any entry that begins to look in disrepair.
7. Entries will be judged on imagination, construction, decoration detail and meets the criteria outlined for lot size and category in which it was entered (i.e. single snowman lot-edible category)
8. Entries will be judged on Wednesday, December 17, 2008. Winners will be notified in person and/or by e-mail no later than January 7, 2009.
9. All entries will be auctioned off to the highest bidder in a silent auction that begins December 1, 2008 and runs through December 23, 2008. All proceeds of the auction will go to local food banks. Auction winners will be notified by December 29, 2008 and must pick up their snowman between January 2nd through January 4th. Any snowman not picked up by January 5, 2009 will be disposed of without prior notice.
10. Suncadia reserves the right to photograph entries for any promotional purposes. Photographs become the property of Suncadia.

Kits can be purchased at the Swim & Fitness Center at Suncadia.

1. Single Snowman Lot consists of a 1' x 1' platform and three foam snowballs (1 of each-6", 4" and 2"). \$5/Kit
2. Snowman Family Lot and School Classroom Lot consists of a 2' x 2' platform and six (2 of each-6", 4" and 2") and six (2 of each-5", 3" and 1.5") foam snowballs. \$10/Kit

Category Rules:

Edible- Any entry in the edible category must consist of materials that would be considered edible with 51% of the total material used in construction falling into that category.

Non-Edible- Entry may contain any materials as long as they are not poisonous or made of dangerous materials. This category can contain edible materials.
