

SUNCADIA SNOW TUBING LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY RELEASE

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE INITIALING AND SIGNING

CONDUCT & SAFETY RULES: *Please initial each line*

- THE MINIMUM AGE FOR A CHILD TO GO TUBING IS 3 YEARS OLD** . Adults and child must ride alone for safety reasons.
- Children must be 42” tall to go tubing .
- Only the provided snow tubes may be used and they must be used in our designated area. No personal sledding devices are allowed at any time.
- Adults are classified as anyone 18yrs and older. It is not recommended that children under the age of 7 participate due to the risk of injury including permanent injury and or death, however; the decision will be made by each child’s parent or guardian.
- Alcohol consumption or being under the influence of alcohol while participating is strictly prohibited.
- No double riding,
- Anyone 12yrs & under must be accompanied by an adult at all times while at the tubing hill.
- No “chains” or “trains” of multiple tubes will be allowed.
- All riders must be sitting upright on tube with all body parts securely within the boundaries of the tube.
- Do not throw snowballs, horseplay on the lifts or other behavior that would be deemed unsafe while in the tubing area. Any such behavior will be subject to warnings and up to removal from the tubing without refund.
- Do not try to stand up or exit the tube until it has come to a complete stop at the bottom of the hill.
- No pets are allowed on or near the tubing hill at any time.

GENERAL LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY RELEASE

1. I accept “as is” condition use of a snow tube and accept full responsibility for the care of the snow tube while in my possession.
2. I understand that there are inherent and other risks involved with snow tubing, including the use of lifts and snow tube, and it is a dangerous activity/sport. These risks include but are not limited to, variations in snow, steepness and terrain, ice and icy conditions, moguls, rocks, trees, and other forms of forest growth or debris (above and below the surface), bare spots, lift terminals, cables, utility lines, snowmaking equipment and component parts, other forms of natural or manmade obstacles on and/or off chutes, as well as collisions with equipment, obstacles, or other snow tubes. Snow chute conditions vary constantly because of weather changes and snow tubing use. These are some of the risks of snow tubing. All of the inherent risks of snow tubing present the risk of serious and/or fatal injury.
3. I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Suncadia Resort its owners, agents, employees and contractors (collectively “the Resort”) from any and all actions, claims, demands or liability for damage and injury to myself or to person or property resulting from the condition, installation, maintenance, and use of the tubing hill and its equipment. I hereby agree that neither I, nor my assignees, heirs, guardians or legal representatives will make a claim against or sue the Resort on account of injury or damage resulting from the negligence or other acts, however caused, by any owner, agent, employee, or contractor of the Resort as a result of my participation in tubing and related activities.
4. I understand and am aware that snow tubing is a HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY. I understand that snow tubing and the use of snow tubes involves a risk of injury to any or all parts of my body. I hereby freely and expressly assume and accept responsibility for any and all risks of injury or death while participating in this activity.
